Sofiel's Gift Riesling 2013

100% Mount Gambier. Single vineyard.

Named after the angel of nature because of the mineral character it has taken from Mount Gambier's harsh rocky soil.

Tasting notes

Being from the ultra-cool Mount Gambier (much colder than Canberra during the growing period), this wine shows huge amounts of blossom, pear and lime sherbet.

Vineyard notes

The bible of Viticulture, Gladstones Wine, Terroir and Climate Change states perfect Riesling is grown between 1200 and 1200 Effective Degree Days (average temperature). Mount Gambier's EDD is 1145. It's the coolest region in mainland Australia, Mount Gambier Riesling shows the true mineral character of it's harsh rocky soil.

The flint and mineral notes are a hint that it will age for well over 20 years.
